<b>FULL ONE-YEAR WARRANTY</b> FROM DATE OF PURCHASE	FSP® replacement parts and repair labor to correct defects in materials or workmanship. Service must be provided by a Whirlpool designated service company.
<b>LIMITED ONE-YEAR WARRANTY</b> SECOND YEAR FROM DATE OF PURCHASE	FSP replacement parts for any part of the POWER CLEAN™ filter module washing system if defective in materials or workmanship. These parts are shown on page 35 of this book.
<b>LIMITED FOUR-YEAR WARRANTY</b> SECOND THROUGH FIFTH YEAR FROM DATE OF PURCHASE	FSP replacement parts for Electronic Control System if defective in materials or workmanship.
<b>FULL TWENTY-YEAR WARRANTY</b> FROM DATE OF PURCHASE	FSP replacement parts and repair labor for the DURAPERM™ tub and/or inner door should they fail to contain water due to defective materials or workmanship. Service must be provided by a Whirlpool designated service company.
